

Virginia Discovery Museum - Group Visit Rules

Share these rules with your group's adult chaperones prior to your Group Visit.

Before You Arrive:

- Groups must have at least one adult chaperone for every four children.
- All adult chaperones must be 18 years old or older.
- The Museum prohibits visitors from carrying firearms, knives, and weapons of any kind, regardless of whether visitors are licensed to carry those weapons. The only exception to this policy is on-duty local police officers and other federal and state law enforcement officers.
- Smoking and alcohol use are prohibited. Visitors under the influence of any legal or illegal substance may not enter.

Your group will be denied entry to the Museum if there are too few adult chaperones or if chaperones are younger than 18.

During Your Visit:

- Children must be supervised by an adult chaperone at all times.
- Food, drinks (except water bottles), and gum are prohibited in the galleries.
- Walk in the Museum galleries; do not run.
- Use inside voices; no shouting or screaming.
- Treat visitors and exhibits with respect. No pushing, hitting, or throwing. Share and return exhibit pieces where they belong after playing.
